What is a dual degree

The dual degree provides a student the opportunity to earn two degrees, **MA from SRH University Germany and MBA from Colorado State University CSU, Fort Collins, Colorado, USA.**

The two degrees may be in two different subjects.

Language

All dual degrees are taught in English. A TOEFL score of 85 required.

How to apply for an MBA dual degree

The decision to take an MBA is not taken until after you have started your SRH programme. Students are invited to attend an information session followed by an online application.

Pre-requisites

All courses at the SRH must be completed successfully prior to departure to the partner university. A minimum average grade of 2 is required.

Master of Business Administration is earned in addition to the SRH MA degree.

Process

Students are guided through the application for the 2nd degree at the partner university by the SRH School of Business International Office, after the start of the SRH MA.

Timeline for the dual degree

Students start their SRH MA degree and complete one year of courses before starting the partner university 2nd degree.

Students complete 2 online courses for the MBA which they are required to pass to continue the MBA. This is followed by 1 semester of courses on campus, at Colorado State University.

Credits earned during the semester at the partner university are recognized towards the SRH MA degree.

Following the semester on campus, students are required to undertake the remaining courses online, (and may need to complete a thesis for completion of the SRH degree if not completed prior to departure), anywhere in the world.



Cost

Students continue to pay SRH fees during the time taken to complete both degrees or for an additional 6 months, whichever is the longer.

No tuition fees are payable to the partner university for the **on campus courses**.

Students **pay for all online courses**, at a discounted rate.

Scholarships for on-campus living costs available.

Students are required to pay their own costs, (health insurance, visa, accommodation etc) for both degrees.

Personal support is provided until both degrees are completed.

Dual degrees are subject to change, by the partner universities.

In the event of cancellation, students are offered an alternative international experience, either an alternative partner dual degree or semester abroad.
